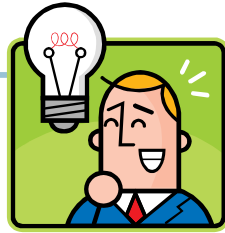


### PUT ON YOUR THINKING CAPS
