## If you come down to Hoogwater Fig Farm in Wolseley you will find Time Out Ladies!



The Hoogwater Farm is 128 km from Cape Town. A beautiful scenic drive from the city, through the Du Toitskloof tunnel. Majestic mountains, showing all their splendour, on a clear, sunny day on which the coach rolled out with 33 passengers, all eager to pick their own figs. Then we headed to Rietdakkie, one of the 'better' equipped padstalletjies on the R43 route to Ceres! I said (jokingly) that they had 5 minutes to buy what they wanted. 45 minutes <u>later</u> and we left with the coach laden with yellow cling peaches; grapes; biscuits; some bottles of Pomegranate Sparkling Wine (which flew off the shelves) and we were ready to head to Melissa's at DuToitskloof Estate.
