Cavalli in Stellenbosch

Cavalli (in Italian this means "**The Horses**") is the training ground for top horses. Under the leadership of Elra Tonkin-Biering whose passion for horses started at the age of 4. Elra started training horses professionally in the mid 70's. She is highly respected as a horse trainer amongst horsemen throughout SA & the USA. Today something very new for us to do will include a tour of their exquisite horse training centre. There is also an **Art Gallery & boutique** on site. There will be ample time for you to view these as well before lunch. Lunch will be in their Bistro. The building is the first green-star rated restaurant in South Africa. The site lies within the heart of the Cape Floral Kingdom—a Unesco World Heritage Site. The philosophy for this restaurant is "It's not only what's on your plate that matters"

The cost for today's trip which includes the Equine Facilities tour, transport & lunch (single course) is R380 per person. (Desserts are available at an additional at R66 per person)
